CAMPAIGN RULES AND REGULATIONS
2022 – 2023

NOTE: Everyone interested in running for office must complete the online application and submit a video clip.

All changes made for the 2022-2023 school year are highlighted.

Student Council/Class Officer applications will be accepted until **Wednesday, March 9, 2022, at 2pm.**

Applications are a **two-part process** for 2022-2023. You must complete the online application and send a video clip stating your name, grade, and candidacy to Ms. Baker or Ms. Harkey by **midnight, March 9, 2022.** Videos must be no longer than 30-seconds and must be school-appropriate. Videos will be shared publicly starting March 21 online through various formats.

GPA Requirements

Candidates for office must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher. You must get a copy of your transcript and it must be signed and verified by the registrar.

Teacher Recommendation

Candidates must list at least one teacher reference on their online application. You must include first and last names, and an email address.

Campaigning

Campaigning will consist of the 30-second video you submitted with your application. This is the only campaigning option for this year. Videos will be shared online through MHS approved platforms.

Posters

Posters must be approved by Mrs. Baker or Mrs. Harkey **BEFORE THEY ARE POSTED in or around the school.**

Handouts

There will be **NO HANDOUTS** for this year. (Handout items include anything tangible: office supplies, pamphlets, candy, etc). If you have a question, direct them to Ms. Baker or Ms. Harkey.

Social Media

You may **not** use social media to campaign! This includes retweets, shares, likes, etc.

Disqualification

School guidelines must be followed in all circumstances. Each candidate must present himself or herself in a positive manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, suggestive, or inappropriate statements made toward another candidate or his/her campaign will not be tolerated, and you will be automatically disqualified.

Voting

Elections will be held online from March 31-April 1, 2022. Voting will be through Canvas Class pages. Links and details to follow. The winner of each office will be based on a plurality of all votes cast for that office.
